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<p class="MsoNormal">At 1402 hours 13 June 2013, notification was received of a<br />

pipeline leak in Franklin Parish near the community of Delhi. Denbury Resources<br />

and Trans Canada are the two companies that have pipe lines in the area.<br />

Denbury shut in all of their lines and confirmed the leak was not theirs. Trans<br />

Canada confirmed the leak was in their lines and that the product leaking is<br />

wrong line was blown the night of 13 June and the leak is ongoing and pressure<br />

readings on the line are not dropping. Trans Canada has a contractor en route.<br />
