

# Tropical Storm DORIAN

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<p class="MsoPlainText">As of 1000 hours CDT, 24 July 2013, NWS/NHC is tracking<br />

one system in the Atlantic-Caribbean-Gulf of Mexico basin, Tropical Storm<br /> DORIAN.&nbsp; </p><br />

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<p class="MsoPlainText">The accompanying graphic shows the current location and<br />

track model for this system.<o:p /></p><br />

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<p class="MsoPlainText">DORIAN is located at 16.0N and 35.9W, about 1800 miles<br />

east of the Northern Leeward Islands. &nbsp;Maximum sustained winds are<br /> currently at 60 mph with higher gust.&nbsp;DORIAN is moving WNW at 17 mph and<br />

is expected to continue that track today, followed by a gradual turn to the<br />

west on Friday.&nbsp;NHC stated that some fluctuation in strength is likely to<br />

occur during the next 48 hours.&nbsp;Tropical storm force winds currently<br />

extend outward up to 60 miles from the center.&nbsp;The estimated minimum<br /> central pressure is at 999MB.<o:p /></p><br />

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<p class="MsoPlainText">Based on current data, if this system survives the<br /> upcoming environmental conditions and tracks straight toward Louisiana, it is<br /> still at least 8 or 9 days from any potential impact on Louisiana.<o:p /></p><br />

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
