<p style="margin: 0in 0in 0pt"><u>SITUATION:</u> GOHSEP is currently monitoring an upper level disturbance that is producing winter weather in regions of the state this week. A cold front is moving through the state today and is expected to stall over the region, setting up for a few different scenarios. Currently, the central and northern parishes are forecast to see some winter weather, while the southern parishes are forecast to see rainfall with totals reaching almost 3 inches through Wednesday. Winter Weather Advisories and Winter Storm Warnings have already been issued for multiple regions throughout the state. GOHSEP will continue to monitor this fluid situation throughout its entirety. </p><font
