Currently,&nbsp; the central and northern parishes are forecast to see some winter weather, while the southern parishes are forecast to see rainfall with totals reaching almost 3 inches through Wednesday. &nbsp;Winter Weather Advisories and Winter Storm Warnings have already been issued for multiple regions throughout the state.
