Baton Rouge, La. - The Department of Transportation and Development (DOTD) announced today that the Plaquemine/Sunshine ferry landing has returned to service.</p>

<p>The ferry initially closed Tuesday afternoon due to deteriorating weather conditions caused by Hurricane Isaac. The operating hours for the Plaquemine/Sunshine ferry landing are 4 a.m. to 9 p.m. seven days per week.</p>

<p>The two remaining landings, White Castle and Edgard/Reserve, will remain closed until further notice.</p>
