

Threat Level 4 of 4

<p>1 - Marginal</p> <p>Isolated/Localized flash flooding possible</p>	<p>2 - Slight</p> <p>Scattered flash flooding possible, with urban areas most vulnerable</p>	<p>3 - Moderate</p> <p>Flash floods likely with significant flash flooding possible.</p>	<p>4 - High</p> <p>Widespread flash flooding expected, with significant flash flooding possible.</p>

OVERVIEW

WHAT...Widespread flash flooding likely, with significant flash flooding possible

WHEN...This evening and tonight

WHERE...Central LA with greatest threat between Alexandria and Toledo Bend.

THREATS & SAFETY

- Rainfall rates in excess of XX-XX inches per hour possible
- High water rescues may become necessary in some areas
- Significant flash flooding could threaten some structures





Valid 7AM Friday through 7AM Saturday

OVERVIEW

WHAT...Heavy rain could lead to scattered areas of flash flooding

WHEN...Friday afternoon through overnight period.

WHERE...Southwest and Southeast LA

THREATS & SAFETY

- High rainfall rates could overwhelm short-term drainage capacity.
- Ponding of water in low lying and poor drainage areas is likely, with some road closures possible, especially in the moderate risk area

Be extra careful if driving at night


