**WebEOC Incident:** 24-022 Grosse Tete Bridge – Jun06

**INCIDENT OBJECTIVES**

1. Ensure the safety of the public and first responders during event
2. Clear and maintain roadways and waterways to facilitate safe transportation and provide timely information to drivers about road and waterway conditions
3. Secure and protect vulnerable infrastructure such as public water systems
4. Ensure the availability and efficient use of resources

- Mostly sunny, with a high near 91
- Calm wind becoming north around 5 mph in the afternoon

Water Systems	<p><b><u>Drinking Water:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Intracoastal Water System West has shut off their intake of source water out of caution; water in storage is approximately 1.5 days worth</li> <li>• They opened up their interconnection with Intracoastal Water System East out of an abundance of caution</li> <li>• No customers are affected at this time</li> </ul>
HazMat	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Iberville OHSEP reported that the lead barge was an empty Styrene Barge. No Release</li> <li>• A non-recoverable amount of hydraulic oil was released from the bridge. Release not ongoing</li> </ul>
