**INCIDENT OVERVIEW**

**WebEOC Incident:** 24-033 TS Francine - Statewide - Sep  
**Activation Level:** 3  
**State Declaration:** JML 24-142

**INCIDENT OBJECTIVES**

1. Protect life
2. Ensure the safety of the first responders during event
3. Clear and maintain roadways to facilitate safe transportation and provide timely information to drivers about road conditions and potential hazards
4. Secure and protect vulnerable infrastructure such as public water systems and hospitals
5. Ensure the availability and efficient use of resources

**WEATHER**

- Tonight: A chance of showers and thunderstorms before 8pm, then a slight chance of showers between 8pm and 11pm. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 70. Southwest wind around 5 mph becoming calm. Chance of precipitation is 30%.
- Sunday (9/14): A slight chance of showers before 8am, then a slight chance of showers after 3pm. Patchy fog before 9am. Otherwise, mostly sunny, with a high near 86. Calm wind becoming northwest around 5 mph in the afternoon. Chance of precipitation is 20%.

**LSP:**

- Troops are assisting DOTD in clearing roadways of hazards and enforcing road closures
- LANG Military Police officers have partnered with Troop B and Troop NOLA to assist with patrol and recovery efforts
- Mobile Field Force and SWAT have been demobilized from Terrebonne and Lafourche Parish
- Air Support Unit is assisting state agencies and parishes with damage assessment flyovers

**LABEOC**

- Support ESF 7 to fulfill any unfilled requests
- Supporting LED and GOHSEP to produce economic impact report to validate need for Federal assistance

**LANG**

- Guardsmen supporting operations as of 0900, 9/14; troops on duty reduced to 900
- Maintaining mission readiness, and preparing for future operations

**LDWF:**

- All Agents continue to be on standby
- Agents assigned in affected area will continue to provide support and are ready to respond

**LAVOAD:**

- Feeding groups continue to coordinate and adjust mass community feeding as electricity is restored
