WebEOC Incident: 24-033 Potential Tropical Cyclone Six - Statewide - Sep
Activation Level: 3
State Declaration: JML 24-142

INCIDENT OBJECTIVES

1. Protect life
2. Ensure the safety of the first responders during event
3. Clear and maintain roadways to facilitate safe transportation and provide timely information to drivers about road conditions and potential hazards
4. Secure and protect vulnerable infrastructure such as public water systems and hospitals
5. Ensure the availability and efficient use of resources

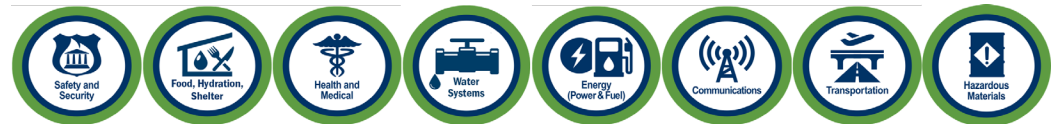
WEATHER

- Potential for damaging winds, mainly in gusts in bands of any heavier rainfall
- Hurricane and Tropical Storm force winds could reach the coast as early as Tuesday (9/10) overnight into Wednesday (9/11), but are most likely to reach the coast by Wednesday (9/11) morning
- Heavy rain could result in flash flooding, pooling in low lying areas, and rises of area rivers
- Possibility of life-threatening inundation from storm surge somewhere in the specified area within the next 48 hours

Lifelines Summary

Safety and Security

LSP:

- LSP will partially activate its EOC and Critical Incident Management Staff (CIMS) beginning 9/10 at 0600 hours for 24-hour operations
- Actively monitoring WebEOC for potential missions and requests
- Checking all assets and resources; Troops will begin clearing roadways of hazards
- Troops are preparing to activate double shifts, and/or supplement shifts beginning as early as Tuesday morning
- Mobile Field Force and Bureau of Investigation (BOI) Rapid Response personnel are on standby to activate as needed
- Public affairs remains engaged with all partners for uniform public safety messaging

DOC:

- Internal EOC staff on standby
- Consumer Protection hotline is up and staffed
- LBI staff on standby

LABEOC:

- The LABEOC is manned operational. The LABEOC will be under extended hours after 0600 tomorrow morning until further notice.
- The LABEOC will host initial coordination call with the private sector at 1500 today and will continue as long as necessary to support response

LANG:

- Initial call up of limited personnel has been initiated
- LANG JOC (TCP) has been activated
- LANG TAC (GOHSEP) has been activated
- ESF16 State EOC personnel are reporting at 0600 on 9/10
- Warehouses are activated for pickup/hotshot

LDWF:

- Enforcement Division is continuing to monitor the event and WebEOC for planning and response
- Contact made with SFMS for planning
- All department personnel have been notified and are on standby for possible staging and deployment
- Department assets are being gathered and tested for future staging and deployment if necessary
- WebEOC team members have been notified; first shift will report to statewide EOC at 0600hrs on 9/10/2024
- MSRT Recon Team has been put on "mission ready status"

Orleans:

- 70 MW of 25 Hz power generation and conversion capacity available, and 90 of 99 major drainage pumps available
- Mass Care and Transportation: Placing three recreation centers on standby status for post event emergency resource centers, should it be necessary

St. Mary:

- Closing all flood gates on Bayou Chene starting tomorrow
- Parish Barns will have Sandbags available, Bayou Vista and Franklin

St. Landry:

- Sandbagging operations are underway; Sandbags have been delivered to all municipalities in the parish

Acadia:

- Town of Church Point - Sand bags will be available at the Town Barn, 411 POW MIA Drive tomorrow (9/10) from 1pm till 6pm. Bring your own shovel to fill your bags. Sand bags and sand will be provided free of charge. A town employee will be there to assist the elderly and handicapped

Designated Regional Coordinators (DRCs) are actively monitoring and messaging facilities in their respective regions for readiness. LDH personnel have reported for shift duty at the GOHSEP site. LDH EOC has been activated Surge Contracts - Surge contracts for ground ambulance support have been assessed and vendors are prepared to respond when/if activated. Oxygen tanks have been requested for pre-staging in Regions 1, 3, 4 and 5 ESF8 Portal - ESF8 portal alerts have been sent to medical infrastructure for situational awareness and requests for facility status and bed poll updates. Critical medical infrastructure currently in intact with no formal requests for assistance
