**WebEOC Incident:** 25-007 Winter Weather – Statewide – Jan1924  
**Activation Level:** Crisis Action Team  
**State Declaration of Emergency:** JML 25-012

**INCIDENT OBJECTIVES**

1. Ensure the safety of the first responders during event
2. Clear and maintain roadways to facilitate safe transportation and provide timely information to drivers about road conditions and potential hazards
3. Secure and protect vulnerable infrastructure such as public water systems and hospitals
4. Ensure the availability and efficient use of resources




