INCIDENT OVERVIEW

WebEOC Incident: 25-007 Winter Weather – Statewide – Jan1924

Activation Level: Level 3

State Declaration of Emergency: JML 25-012

INCIDENT OBJECTIVES

1. Ensure the safety of the first responders during event
2. Clear and maintain roadways to facilitate safe transportation and provide timely information to drivers about road conditions and potential hazards
3. Secure and protect vulnerable infrastructure such as public water systems and hospitals
4. Ensure the availability and efficient use of resources


WEATHER

This Afternoon



Mostly cloudy during the early evening, then becoming clear, with a low around 12. North wind around 5 mph becoming calm after midnight.



Transportation

DOTD:

- *511 Traveler Information:* Travelers can find information regarding road closures by downloading the Louisiana 511 mobile app or by visiting the 511 Traveler Information website at <https://www.511la.org>; This website offers updates in real time, along with access to our live-stream traffic cameras.
- *MyDOTD:* Motorists can receive up-to-date information on local projects, lane and road closures, and other DOTD activity by signing up via email for MyDOTD at <https://www.dotd.la.gov>.
- *DOTD on Social Media:* Find DOTD on social media for updates and information and follow on Facebook, Instagram and X
- Monitoring weather calls and WebEOC; have begun pretreating winter weather priority routes and elevated sections; staging equipment and resources based on NWS forecasted impacts
- DOTD MAP Patrol has begun 24/7 Patrol Operations in the 6 MAP Patrol Regions, with patrol shifts being extended to 12 Hrs shifts with 20 units operating

MSY New Orleans Airport reports all airlines have deicing equipment ready and plan to operate as normal runway and taxiways are safe to use. Air Canada has no deicing equipment and they are unsure how they will operate at this time; flights cancelled 21 JAN 2025:: British Airways, Southwest, Spirit, American, Alaska, Delta

 - Twin Parish Port/Port of Delcambre – operations closed
 - Lake Charles Port – tenant operations closed
 - Morgan City Port and Harbor - closed
- The U.S. Coast Guard has advised the Red River Waterway is closed to barge movements in Alexandria due to the closure of the U.S. Hwy 165 Bridge to vehicle and marine traffic.

Lafourche Parish

- The Cote Blanche Pontoon bridge and the Galliano Pontoon bridge will be tied open

- The I-49 elevated in Alexandria will be closed through the city during the weather event

Bossier Parish

- NWLA DOTD has at the direction of State began to brine the overpasses and bridges in anticipation for any measurable precipitation

Plaquemines Parish

- Empire Swingbridge has been repaired and now open to vehicular traffic ONLY
- Belle Chasse Ferry is out of service due to weather conditions; ramps and deck of the ferry being very slick and ice forming; It is operational for emergency use only for first responders
- The Empire Highrise on LA Hwy 23 is closed
- Woodland Bridge closed by DOTD

St. Bernard Parish

- Violet Bridge closed; all other roads remain open

St. Mary

- US 90 Eastbound at Bayou Boeuf Bridge in Amelia is shut down at Troop C's request
- US 90 East due to icing on the Boeuf Bridge and elevated section in Assumption
- LA 182 will be maintained to be open in Amelia.

West Baton Rouge Parish

- I-10 / I-110 closed

Pointe Coupee

- Audubon Bridge (Mississippi River) closed

East Feliciana Parish

- Numerous Motor Vehicle Accidents; State Hwy 952, Hwy 68 closed at all bridges, not sanded
- Hwy 964 closed due to ice caused 18 wheeler to overturn, extended amount of time to remove truck; parish sanded all concrete bridges

Catahoula

- Duty Ferry on Hwy 559 closed due to icing

Orleans Parish

- Has secured snow plow / salt spreader vehicles that will be deployed as soon as the weather event stops

Acadia

- Hwy 90 bridge in Mermentau is starting to freeze over; Local PD advising to stay off roads; DOTD is aware




- Following Bridges closed on 21 JAN 2025:
