1. Ensure the safety of the first responders during event
2. Clear and maintain roadways to facilitate safe transportation and provide timely information to drivers about road conditions and potential hazards
3. Secure and protect vulnerable infrastructure such as public water systems and hospitals
4. Ensure the availability and efficient use of resources

WEATHER

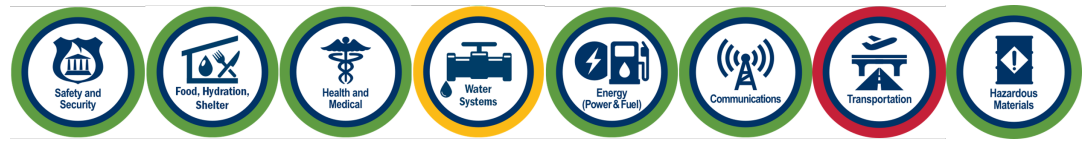

Then there's Tuesday's snows: for the southern half of the state, the deluge ranks as the 2nd largest total on the books since the "super snow" of February 1895.

Sunny, with a high near 31. Calm wind.

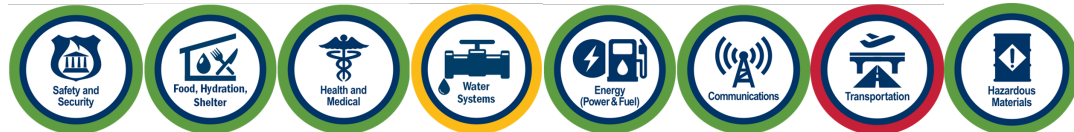
Tonight

Partly cloudy, with a low around 16. Calm wind.



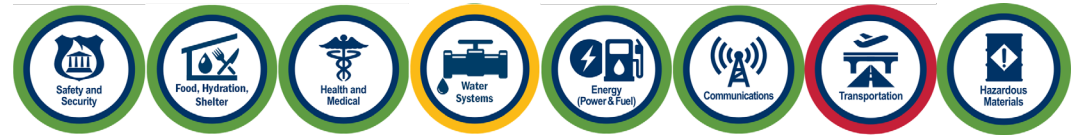

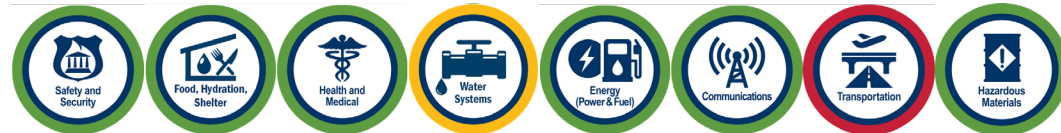

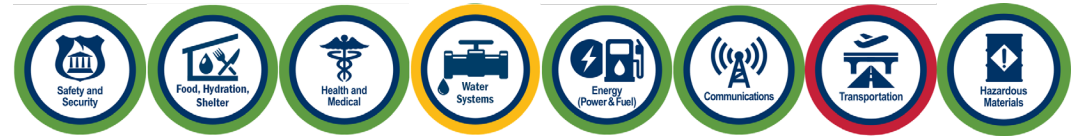
