INCIDENT OBJECTIVES

1. Ensure the safety of the first responders during event
2. Clear and maintain roadways to facilitate safe transportation and provide timely information to drivers about road conditions and potential hazards
3. Secure and protect vulnerable infrastructure such as public water systems and hospitals
4. Ensure the availability and efficient use of resources

WEATHER

- Tonight: A 50 percent chance of showers and thunderstorms, mainly between 3am and 5am. Cloudy, with a low around 57. South wind 5 to 10 mph. New rainfall amounts of less than a tenth of an inch, except higher amounts possible in thunderstorms.
- Saturday: Cloudy, then gradually becoming mostly sunny, with a high near 70. Southwest wind 5 to 10 mph becoming northwest in the afternoon.
