**INCIDENT OBJECTIVES**

1. Ensure the safety of all individuals present, including public, first responders, and emergency personnel involved in response
2. Coordinate with ESFs to ensure consistent resource sharing and response
3. Maintain effective communication channels to disseminate information to the public, first responders, and emergency personnel involved in response
4. Protect the environment, wildlife, fishing industry, and coastal infrastructure
5. Adapt objectives based on changing incident conditions to maintain response

**Today:**

Mainly Fair, highs in the low 80s. SE winds 5-10 mph, occasional gusts to 15 mph. High Tide 1.6ft at 1140.

**Overnight:**

Becoming mostly cloudy, lows around 70. SE winds 5-10 mph. Low Tide 0.0ft as 0007.

Hotline# (832)514-9663</li> <li>• WRS arrived in Venice, LA on 28 APR 2025 to begin setting up wildlife rehabilitation center</li> <li>• Planning and information gathering is ongoing on scene</li> <li>• Observations from the overflight indicate the oil sheen is more expansive than anticipated. Sheen was observed from approximately 1 mile south of Wildlife Management Area (WMA) HQ to the edge of the bay/gulf.</li> <li>• Wildlife Surveys will most likely occur beginning on 30 APR 2025</li> <li>• Staff will participate in the IAP (Incident Action Planning) at the command center in Belle Chasse</li> <li>• A wildlife response team will survey the impact area to search for impacted wildlife and gather info for the development of a response plan; The survey will determine initial equipment and personnel needs that will lead to an expanded response on 1 MAY 2025 and beyond</li> </ul>
