INCIDENT OBJECTIVES

1. Ensure the safety of the public and first responders during the event
2. Clear and maintain roadways to facilitate safe transportation and provide timely information to drivers about road conditions and potential hazards
3. Maintain effective communication channels to disseminate information to the public, first responders, and emergency personnel involved
4. Secure and protect vulnerable infrastructure such as electric grids
5. Ensure the availability and efficient use of resources

Today:


Scattered showers, occasional t-storms, rain chances 60%. Highs in the upper 70s near 80, SE Winds 10-15 mph, occasional gusts 15-20 mph.

Overnight:

Scattered showers & t-storms, rain chances 50%. Lows around 70, SE Winds 10-15 mph.

Tomorrow:

Showers and occasional t-storms, rain chances 80%. Highs in the upper 70s near 80, SE winds 5-15 mph.
