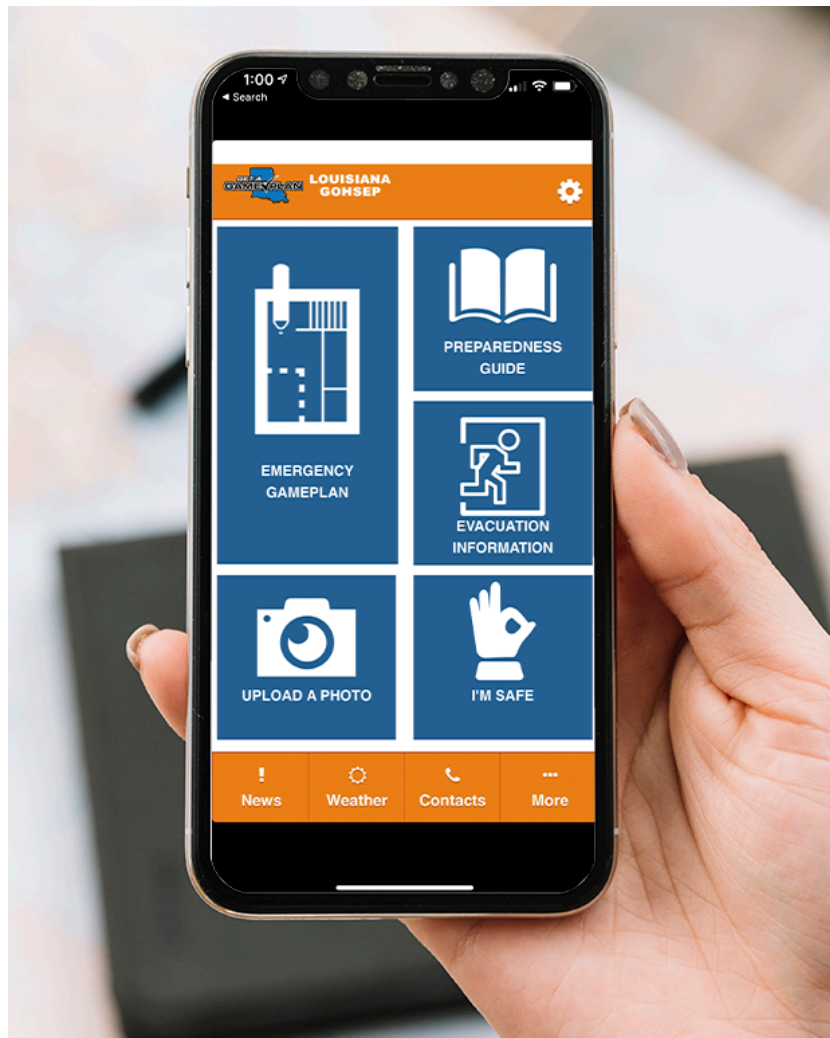

The Louisiana Get A Game Plan App is the official emergency preparedness mobile app provided by the Louisiana Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP).

This app allows Louisiana residents to access emergency information on the go and get prepared prior to an emergency happening. Users can prepare customized emergency plans, review the Louisiana Emergency Preparedness Guide, and get up-to-date information about evacuations. The app even allows you to notify family and friends that you are safe in the event of an emergency. Real-time notifications are sent directly to the device from GOHSEP to provide the most up-to-the-minute information for residents.
